Our curriculum focuses on play-way learning and theatre approaches empathizing concept learning through engaging activities.

NIOS - Inclusive Education

The Resource Room in KMBVM started functioning from 2006 and this year we have 60 students in total who have been identified as having special needs.

From grade 1 to 8, there are 58 students in total attending remedial training in the resource room. We have 23 students from the primary block and 2 from

KG who are availing the help of shadow teachers. The special needs of these children are varied like Specific Learning Disability, ADHD, Down syndrome, Autism and Cerebral Palsy. Each child is screened and the specific special need is identified. After detailed discussion with teachers and parents, an individualized plan is finalized according to the level and need of the child.

Training is given to the child, each little improvement is noted and further plans are decided to improve the deficit skills in the Individualized Education Plan.

NIOS Students had a diverse learning experience while they watched the movie Sitare Zameen Par at Sobha Mall.

An orientation session was conducted by Smt. Pincy, Secretary of the organization DOST, for the parents of children with different needs. She briefed them about various scholarships and opportunities available for the children.
